

Parents/Guardians Code of Conduct



Little Dreamers is dedicated to establishing a safe and inclusive environment for all members of our community to engage in our activities, events, and programs, free from any form of abusive, insulting, threatening, or anti-social behavior.

We kindly request all parents, guardians, and other supportive adults affiliated with Little Dreamers to:

- ★ Adhere to our organisation's guidelines for parents and guardians.
- ★ If necessary, politely and respectfully remind others of their responsibilities outlined in these guidelines.
- ★ Should a serious or persistent violation of these guidelines occur involving another individual, please report the matter to a staff member promptly. This will enable us to take appropriate action.

Guidelines for Parents and Guardians

Our foremost priority is ensuring the participation, enjoyment, and safety of all children, including your own, as well as other children and young people involved in Little Dreamers activities, programs, or events. As parents and guardians, you play a vital role in supporting these objectives by:

- Encouraging your child's participation in a positive manner.
- Informing the Program Lead about any additional support your child may require or develop during the program, such as asthma, allergies, or hearing difficulties, to ensure their safe participation.
- Providing updated contact information to the Intake and Support Coordinators in case of emergencies.
- Refraining from engaging in discriminatory behavior towards any person based on age, gender, race, ability, colour, religion, language, politics, sexual orientation, national or ethnic origin, or ability to live at home.
- Avoiding or threatening violence, physical confrontations, or verbal confrontations with others.
- Maintaining positive interactions with Little Dreamers personnel and refraining from criticising them in the presence of your child. If you have concerns, please report them to the Program Lead.
- Ensuring that your child receives adequate supervision during visits to Little Dreamers events.
- Arranging for timely pickup of your child at the conclusion of an activity.
- Notifying the Program Lead in advance if someone unfamiliar to the program will be picking up your child, and accurately completing the sign-in form.
- Obtaining consent from parents or guardians before taking photos of other children.
- Refraining from requesting personnel to provide any additional support or services beyond the scope of Little Dreamers activities and programs (e.g., babysitting, borrowing money, providing transportation).
- Reporting any concerns about the safety, wellbeing, and welfare of a child or young person to a staff member immediately.

- Providing feedback and contributing to decisions that impact the safety, wellbeing, and welfare of children and young people in Little Dreamers services.

Serious or persistent violations of these guidelines will not be tolerated. Those who breach our guidelines may be asked to leave the program or event and may be prohibited from participating in future engagements.
